Toler Continues to Shine in 09 Cactus Bowl



Lawrenceville, VA - Saint Paul's College senior defensive back Gregory Toler played defense for the West in the 2009 Valero Cactus Bowl, the NCAA Division II All-Star Football game, at Jayelina Stadium, in Kingsville TX. Kick-off was the second Friday in January. Toler helped the West squad end their three-game losing streak, 28-27.

“It was opportunity for me to display my skills for NFL Scouts and to increase my chances to draft to the NFL,” stated Toler when asked about his experience at the Cactus Bowl. “I am extremely grateful to have been provided the opportunity to compete with and against the best talent the country.”

Playing hard in front of 5,000 fans, Toler walked away from the game with 1 interception that he returned for a Cactus Bowl record 44 yards. He ended the 08-09 season leading the CIAA Conference with 6 pass interceptions and ranked third in NCAA Division II with 19 passes defended.

Toler has been invited to participate in the 2009 NFL Scouting Combine at the RCA Dome in Indianapolis from February 18 to 24. Toler will be put through a series of drills, tests and interviews with more than 600 NFL personnel, including head coaches, general managers, and scouts for six days. Scouts from the Tennessee Titans, Atlanta Falcons, Washington Redskins, and others, have visited Saint Paul's campus to review game footage and to interview Toler.
