Toler and Stokes Named CIAA Players of the Week



Lawrenceville, VA: October 2, 2008 - Senior defensive back Gregory Toler and sophomore defensive end Jarvis Stokes both earned CIAA Player of the Week honors for their week five efforts against the Johnson C. Smith University Golden Bulls on September 27. Toler and Stokes helped lead the Tigers to a 24-9 victory over the Golden Bulls, improving the Tigers to a 3-2 overall record and the first CIAA conference win of the season.

Gregory Toler is a 6 foot 180 pound defensive back from Washington D.C. Thought of as one of the best defensive players in the conference, Toler was named to the 2008 Pre-season ALL-CIAA Conference Team. With the Tigers already completing the first half of their season, Toler has continuously shown why he is ALL-CIAA caliber. Toler leads the conference in interceptions (3) and passes break-ups (7). He is also ranked 18th in the conference in total tackles (30).



Toler secured the title of Defensive Back of the Week in the game against JCSU by posting a total of 7 tackles, one for a loss of two yards, one interception, and two pass break-ups. Toler currently leads the Tigers defensive unit in tackles, interceptions, and pass break-ups.

2007 All-CIAA Rookie Team member Jarvis Stokes' domination of Johnson C. Smith's offensive line earned him the title of Defensive Lineman of the Week for week five. Stokes, a six foot two inch defensive end from Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, finished the game with six tackles -- two for a loss of six yards -- and one sack for a loss of five yards. Stokes currently has 22 total tackles (five tackles for loss), two sacks, two quarterback hurries, and one pass break-up for the 2008 season.
